

## Travel and Lodging Information for AIDSWatch

*Please start making any necessary travel arrangements as soon as possible. If you are traveling to DC, you should plan to arrive on Sunday, April 26, because the advocacy training will start early the morning of Monday, April 27. The advocacy training will take place at the Charles Sumner School Museum and Archives at 1201 17<sup>th</sup> Street, NW near the Farragut North Metro stop.*

Advocacy meetings on Capitol Hill will take place on Tuesday, April 28 and Wednesday, April 29 (the closest Metro stops are Capitol South on the blue line for meetings with Members of the House of Representatives and Union Station on the red line for meeting with Member of the Senate). *Please book your outgoing flight in the early evening or later on April 29 so you can attend advocacy meetings all day.*

The cost of lodging in Washington has increased over past years **BUT** we've been able to secure a reasonably priced room block for registrants of AIDSWatch. The block is on a first-come first-serve bases and the rate is 209.00 per night subject to 14.5% tax. We urge you to book as soon as you can! The rooms are at Kimpton's very friendly, Hotel Rouge, right in the heart of Dupont Circle, and just 3 blocks away from the Charles Sumner School Museum.
